Business Prereqs (advisor can override with the following rules):

ACCT 2010 - No prerequisite. Should be taken as early as possible.

ACCT 3350 - No prerequisite. This class is HARD so warn students as appropriate and have them

take it during Junior or Senior year. No class requires Business law as a prerequisite so it can be taken any time.

MGMT 3050 - Requires Junior Standing. MGMT 3340 - MGMT 3180.

FIN 3250 - MATH 1040, MATH 1050, ACCT 2010. ACCT 2010 is the big one.

MGMT 3100 - ACCT 2010, MATH 1040, MATH 1050. If students have these three classes, you may

override the student attribute error.

MGMT 3180 - Requires Junior standing. You may override this if Business Core is done. Ideally, student will have completed ENGL 2010 and INFO 1010.

ENGL 2010 and INFO 1010.

ENTR 3210 - ACCT 2010 and FIN 3250. This is a change from previous catalog iterations. Please do not override these prerequisites as much of this class will focus on capital budgeting which they learn extensively in FIN 3250.

MGMT 3240 - MGMT 3180.

MGMT 4100 - Requires advanced standing.
