## **Catch That Cookie**

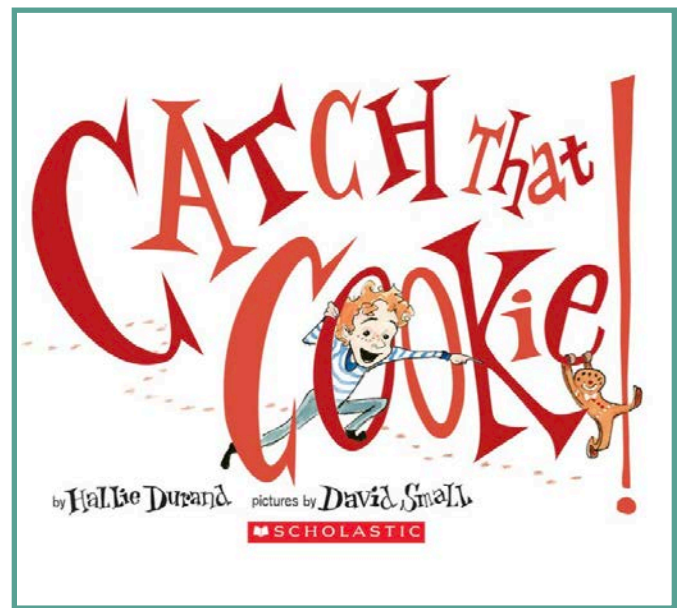
Today we will be making Gingerbread Cookies inspired from the book *Catch That Cookie* by Hallie Durand. In this book, the children make cookies and they run loose! Today, we will be decorating our very own gingerbread cookies.

## **Instructions for your Gingerbread Cookie:**

### **Materials Needed:**

- Printed gingerbread man outline handouts
- String, buttons, paper, and any other art or craft materials you want to decorate your gingerbread man

Here is an example of some gingerbread men with some ideas on how you can create your own! Is your gingerbread cookie a boy or a girl? Do they look like you? What can you make their hair, nose, eyes, buttons and clothes out of? Listen to the book, and then use the materials around your house to create your gingerbread man!



## STEP 1:

Attached to this lesson is an outline of a gingerbread man. Print out that paper, and then color in the body and the face.

## STEP 2:

Once you are done coloring, cut out your gingerbread man. After it's all cut out, you can start adding things to make it more unique. You could add string, buttons, beads, paper shapes, fabric, stickers and anything else you want.

## STEP 3:

Place everything you want to add on your gingerbread man first, and then go through and glue it all down.

## STEP 4:

Once it's all finished, give your gingerbread man a name. You have made your very own gingerbread man!

## STEP 5:
