Bill: Support and Funding for T-Bird Bikes

WHEREAS: The Southern Utah University Student Association supports sustainable transportation in Cedar City and student created and run campus organizations. As such, the Southern Utah University Student Association supports the T-Bird Bikes organization.

WHEREAS: T-Bird Bikes seeks to receive a \$5,000 grant from the Southwest Utah Public Health Department. The organization has raised \$1,000 from other organizations, and has created a detailed plan on how funding will be spent. Key points include renting bikes to students for free, teaching students bike safety and maintenance, and assessing bikeability of campus. The organization, though under Campus Recreation, does not receive funding from the university.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The Southern Utah University Student Association Senate will grant \$2,000 to T-Bird Bikes to allow them to reach the necessary \$3,000 to receive the grant from the Southwest Utah Public Health Department.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED: This funding will come from the Student Senate fund, used to enhance the lives of SUU students by helping them feel connected to campus.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED: T-Bird Bikes will be required to present their progress and use of Senate funding to the Student Senate during the Spring 2021 semester.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED: This bill is in support of creating a more sustainable transportation environment on campus, as well as encouraging and assisting student activism.
