



SR #23/24-02: Improvement of Parking at Southern Utah University

WHEREAS: It is the responsibility of the Southern Utah University Student Association (SUUSA) to advocate for the best interests of the student body and work in partnership with university administration to address pressing issues;

WHEREAS: The student body of Southern Utah University has voiced numerous concerns and complaints regarding the current state of parking facilities and services on campus;

WHEREAS: Convenient and efficient parking is integral to the overall safety of campus as well as essential for the well-being and academic success of our students, faculty, and staff;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SOUTHERN UTAH UNIVERSITY STUDENT ASSOCIATION THAT:

1. Section 1: The SUUSA Student Senate acknowledges the diligent efforts made to collect data and insights on campus parking through a survey conducted among 338 students;
2. Section 2: The survey revealed importing findings that inform the pressing need for improvements in campus parking. These findings include:

- a. The majority of students believe that paying for parking passes are not worth the investment as they believe they will not find parking in the paid student lots.
 - b. Students believe that the solutions for the parking issues at hand include: building more parking, more strictly regulating and patrolling paid lots, and/or making all parking free for students.
3. Section 3: In response to the survey findings, the SUUSA Student Senate hereby resolves that the following actions be taken to improve parking on campus:

4. Section 4: The SUUSA Student Senate commits to collaborating with university administrators, facilities management, and transportation departments to advocate for the implementation of recommended improvements based on survey findings.
